Undeserved Makeup Assignments for the 2nd Nine Weeks, 2010

Directions: All makeup assignments must show the complete heading as explained in class policies and procedures. Use the assignment names listed below when you indicate the makeup assignment on the top left hand side of each assignment. Work turned in by Friday, December 17th can earn a 70 if it is done completely and correctly. The last day for makeup work is Wednesday, January 5, 2011, and can earn at most a 50.

1. **Monkey's Paw Essay.** There are two parts to the assignment. You must first complete prewriting, then write the essay. Your prewrite must contain (1) a thesis statement, (2) at least 6 examples (=quotations) from the story, and (3) a bubble map, brainstorm or outline. The prompt: Evaluate how the conflict(s) between reality and truth articulate theme in "The Monkey's Paw." Include at least three examples from the text to support your thesis.
2. **Allusions in *Paradise Lost*.** List all allusions used in the first 16 lines of *Paradise Lost* and explain what the allusions mean.
3. **Punctuating Dialogue Exercises.** Download this worksheet if you've "lost" yours. It's further down on 2nd 9 Weeks handouts.
4. **Brainypix Vocabulary Words.** Use the Brainypix template listed above. You need to choose 5 words from the gotbrainy website each week (www.gotbrainy.com). Write out the part of speech, definition listed on the website, and use each word in a sentence of your own creation. Then, using the Brainypix Powerpoint template (download from the link on the "Handouts" page), find a picture that provides a visual for each sentence you've created. Staple sentences underneath your Powerpoint printout. **If you put more than 2 Powerpoint slides on a page, I won't grade your work.** You do not have to send me an email with the Powerpoint files. I only want the printout and the sentences.
5. ***Paradise Lost* explication.** Explicate means to put each line of a poem into your own words. Explicate all of Book X (the last page of your handout). If you've "lost" your *Paradise Lost* handout, borrow from a friend because I can't help you with this handout.
6. **"Rime of the Ancient Mariner" questions.** Answer the following:
 - a. Write a **three sentence** plot summary of this narrative poem. Don't write two sentences or five sentences or one sentence: write **THREE** sentences.
 - b. Write a thematic statement for one of the major themes in the poem.
 - c. Choose a short passage that speaks to you, write it down, cite it correctly, and explain why you think it's important.
7. ***Frankenstein* study questions chapters 10-12.** Complete *Frankenstein* study questions for Chapters 10-12. **Make sure your answers are in complete sentences.**
